
Common consultation from other departments

OPHTHALMOLOGY (EYE)	Endophthalmitis, retinitis, uveitis, keratitis
OTOLARYNGOLOGY (ENT)	Fungal sinusitis, deep neck space infection, parotid abscess
OB/GYNS	Fever in CA cervix/CA ovary/CA endometrium
ORTHROPEDICS	Chronic osteomyelitis, Prosthetic joint infections, r/o TB spine
PMR	UTI
SURGERY	Fever in post op abdominal surgery/CA colon/CHCA/CNS SHUNT/GRAFT

Endophthalmitis

- infection inside the eye involving the vitreous and/or aqueous humors

Acute post-cataract	Coagulase-negative staphylococci (70% of cases), other Gram-positive cocci (25%)
Chronic post-cataract	<i>Propionibacterium acnes</i>
Post-injection	Coagulase-negative staphylococci, viridans streptococci
Bleb-related	Streptococci, <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i>
Post-traumatic	<i>Bacillus cereus</i> , coagulase-negative staphylococci (fungi in some cases)
Endogenous bacterial	<i>Staphylococcus aureus</i> , streptococci, Gram-negative bacilli (e.g. <i>Klebsiella</i>)

Endogenous endophthalmitis

- bacteremic seeding of the eyes
- Endocarditis related 40%
- urinary tract infections
- indwelling central venous catheters
- illicit injection drug use
- procedures such as endoscopy
- In Taiwan, Singapore, and SEA, liver abscess caused by *Klebsiella pneumoniae* is the source of 60% of cases

Endogenous endophthalmitis

- Blood cultures are positive in 75% of cases, as are vitreous cultures
- Treatment of the underlying source of bacteraemia with systemic antibiotics is necessary
- but this will not effectively treat the endophthalmitis: intravitreal antibiotics and, usually, a vitrectomy are necessary

Endophthalmitis

- Positive cultures were found in 172 (41.25%) of 417 eyes.
 - Bacteria were isolated in 157 eyes (91.28%), Gram positives in 20 eyes (76.43%) and Gram negatives in 37 eyes (23.57%)
 - fungi in eight eyes (4.65%)
 - mixed organisms in seven eyes (4.07%)

- coagulase-negative *Staphylococcus* (36), *Bacillus* spp. (24), *Streptococcus pneumonia* (20), β -hemolytic streptococcus (12), *Pseudomonas* spp. (9), *Klebsiella* spp. (9), and *Enterococcus* spp. (8)
 - Post-traumatic - *Bacillus* spp.
 - Post-operative - coagulase-negative *Staphylococcus*.
 - Endogenous - Group B β hemolytic Streptococcus, *Klebsiella* spp., and *Escherichia coli*







RETINAL PROBLEMS

- CMV retinitis
- Posterior outer retinal necrosis (PORN)
- Acute retinal necrosis (ARN)

RETINAL PROBLEMS

- CMV retinitis
- Ganciclovir 5 mg/kg q 12 hr + intravitreous ganciclovir x 14d + ART -> maintenance intravitreous GCV 2-3/WK until CD4 > 50/mm³
- Posterior outer retinal necrosis (PORN)
- Acute retinal necrosis (ARN)
- HZV most common cause
- Acyclovir 10 mg/kg iv q 8 hr -> oral form ≥ 14 d

KERATITIS

- Fungal keratitis
- *Fusarium*
- Surgery + Voriconazole topical
- *Pythium*
- Surgery
